Fees for overseas students are payable yearly in advance by the due date stated on the invoice. Payments regarding passport, visa renewals and medical insurance are the responsibility of the family.

For all new students a non-refundable enrolment administration fee is charged following the interview and confirmation of enrolment. This amount is shown above and relative to the year the student is enrolling into.

The HSC examination fee is paid directly to the National Education Standards Authority, (NESA), on application to sit for the NSW Higher School Certificate in Year 12. This will be billed separately to the student on their Annual invoice.

Where provisional acceptance is required, the School charges an Enrolment Administration to hold the position. This fee is non-refundable (unless visa is not granted) and will be credited against fees when the student is fully accepted.

Dismissal from the School for any misdemeanour may result in the forfeiture of all or part of tuition fees paid in that year.

The level of fees is determined by the Board of Directors for each ensuing year and is reviewed annually each year. Parents are reminded that other incidental costs should also be considered. Individual private music lessons are available at an additional charge payable directly to tutor.

Refund of course monies

- Georges River Grammar's refund policy applies to all course monies paid to the school and includes any course monies paid to an education agent to be remitted to the school.

- b. All notification of withdrawal from a course, or applications for refunds, must be made in writing and submitted to the Enrolments Registrar.
- c. The School will refund within 28 days all course monies paid where the student's application for enrolment is refused by the School or the student produces evidence that the application made by the student for a student visa has been rejected by the Australian immigration authorities.
- d. Refunds for student default apply to tuition fees only. Course monies (excluding tuition fees) will be refunded on a pro rata basis proportional to the amount of time the student was studying in the course, except where a non-refundable payment on behalf of the student has been made.
- e. If the student does not provide written notice of withdrawal and does not start the course on the agreed starting date, one term's (ten weeks) tuition fees will be kept by the School, in lieu of notice.
- f. The school will refund within 28 days of the receipt of written notification of withdrawal by the parent(s)/legal guardian, tuition fees paid less the amounts to be retained as agreed and detailed below.
 - a) If written notice is received up to 4 weeks prior to commencement of the course, the school will be entitled to retain an administration fee. This will be the amount of the Enrolment Administration Fee.
 - b) All other fees will be refunded unless covered by Item g.
- g. No refund of tuition fees will be made where a student's enrolment is cancelled for any of the following reasons:
 - a) Failure to maintain satisfactory course progress (visa condition 8202)
 - b) Failure to maintain satisfactory attendance (visa condition 8202)
 - c) Failure to maintain approved welfare and accommodation arrangements (visa condition 8532) [if applicable]
 - d) Failure to pay course fees
 - e) Any behaviour identified as resulting in enrolment cancellations in Georges River Grammar's Behaviour Policy/Code of Conduct.
- h. This agreement and the availability of complaints and appeals processes does not remove the right of the student to take action under Australia's consumer protection laws.
